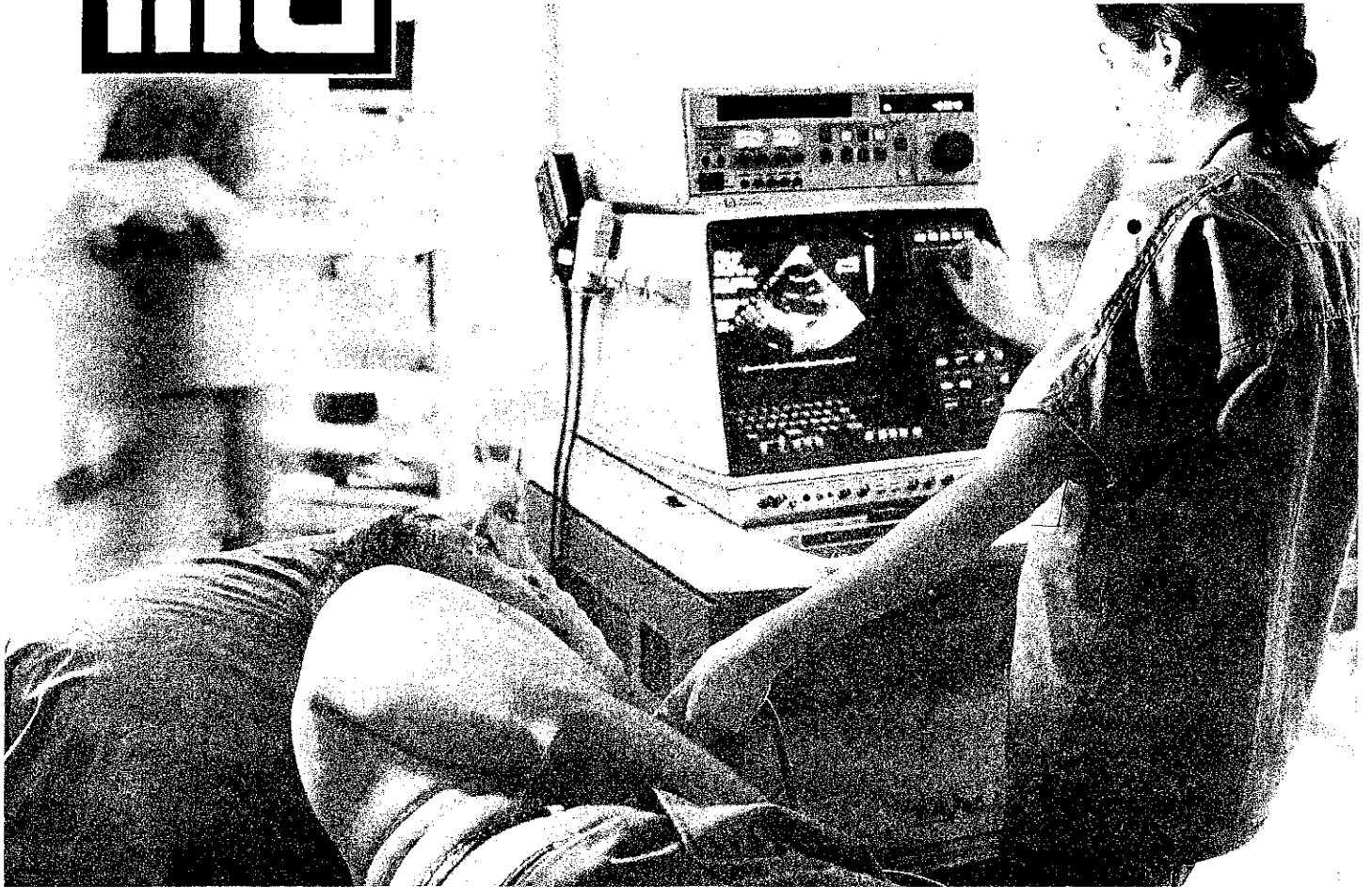

ULTRASOUND TECHNICIAN - Diagnostic Sonography

DEFINITION - Seeing with Sound

High-Frequency sound waves create body images which in turn tell us what is happening inside the human body. Ultrasound can determine if a tumor is present, or tell if a mother is carrying twins long before the first heartbeat can be heard.

The benefit of Ultrasound is that it involves no risk to the patient. Use of sound waves to investigate the body is performed safely, without radiation or harmful side effects.

The Ultrasound Technician is an individual trained to perform various testing methods for viewing, monitoring and recording the internal organs and tissues of the body.
